#### Safeguarding...

Teachers are not able to release children to anyone other than their usual nominated adults without prior notification via the going home books or informing the office. If you do want your child to go home with another parent or are sending a new adult who is unknown to us you must notify the office so that it can be recorded in our going home books as early in the day as possible.

Teachers have been instructed that they must not release children without notification and managing getting in contact with you at the end of the day can be time consuming and inconvenient. To keep things running smoothly please ensure that you personally notify your class teacher or the office of any changes to pick up arrangements and ask unknown adults to be prepared to show a named ID to the teacher. If there are adults



that you are happy to consent to taking your child on any day please ensure that it is written in the going home books and that the office has all of their details.
