


# Year 1

## Reminders...

### **Safeguarding**

Please can I remind all parents of the importance of checking the front gate to ensure that it is always closed and bolted. This is paramount to keeping children at Moss Lane safe.

#### **Going home books**

These are black books that are located by the front door for Years 1 and 2 and in the class-rooms for Reception. If for any reason you are unable to collect your child at the end of the school day, or if they are going home with a friend, please write this in the going home books. Teachers check these books daily. We will not allow a child to go home with another adult if it has not been written in these books. If you have any last minute change of plans, please call the office so they can pass a message onto the class teacher. Please do not email the school with changes to pick up arrangements as emails are not always read in time.

#### PΕ

PE kits should be kept in school at all times. Please ensure that your child has suitable footwear (plimsolls/trainers) for outside P.E. You may also wish to provide jogging bottoms as well as shorts for outside sessions.

#### Clubs

Can I also remind all parents that you collect your child from the playground after their club.

#### Access to school after 9.00 am

If your child is late for whatever reason including medical appointments, please ensure that you bring them to the office where we will mark them in the register and take them to their classroom. This includes children in the reception classes. If your child is going to be late, please ensure the office is advised before 9.15am.

#### **Absence from school**

Please ring before 9.15 am if your child is going to be absent for any reason including medical appointments. We can then ensure that their class teacher and anyone else who is affected by their absence is told. Absence for medical appointments should be advised in advance of the date wherever possible. A letter explaining any absence should also be brought in to the school office. Absence request forms are available from the school office or you can download one of our website.

#### School Office Hours

The office is open from 8.45am until 3.30pm. The office stocks school book bags, water bottles and phonic wallets should you wish to purchase any. To stop long queues at the office can I remind you that any monies / letter can also be posted in the red post box opposite the office window (not to be confused with the PTA post box!).

#### <u>Uniform</u>

All children should be in their winter uniform after half term.

#### **Birthdays**

Please note we are healthy school and don't encourage the distribution of sweets and cakes in class on a child's birthday.
