Governors were advised of low pupil numbers:

Budget is based on 175 pupils. If numbers don't increase before Census mid October there will be a significant impact to the school budget.

School are currently recruiting for one teaching assistant, no applications received and there is currently one teaching assistant on long term sick leave.

School have successfully recruited a woodland school leader who is Level 3 trained to run ½ day session at Witley Centre this term and then review provision.
