Here are a few ideas

Meath Wear It Purple

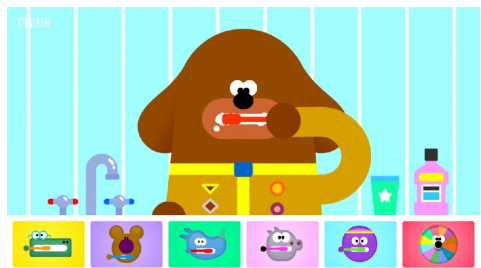
