

## Activities:

- 3. Prepare/draw the layout of your report. Remember to include space for a topic title, introduction paragraph, 2-3 paragraphs with sub headings, fact box with bullet points and diagram/map. Example below.
- 4. Write up your NCR. Remember to use formal and technical language. Don't forget that correct spelling and punctuation is super important.
- 5. Re-read your NCR. Edit it your work: check your spellings and punctuation. Do all of your sentences make sense? Have you included plenty of information?
