

Moss Lane School Swashbuckle Scramble



Dear Parent/Carer,

On **Wednesday 13th March** we will be holding a sponsored 'Swashbuckle Scramble' event in school. This will help raise much needed PTA funds, which this year are being put towards an outdoor classroom and second set of class iPads.

Your child is invited to come to school on Wednesday 13th March wearing their own clothes with a pirate theme. This can be anything from a stripy t-shirt to full pirate costume. Children should be able to move freely and use the toilet independently in their costume. The Swashbuckle Scramble will take place during the school day.

The rules for this event are very simple:

- ❖ The children collect sponsors for the amount of treasure (gold coins) they can collect from a ball pit in one minute.
- ❖ The children will have 1 minute to collect as many gold coins as they can, and drop them into a treasure bucket. The coins will then be counted and the amount collected will be recorded on their sponsor form and certificate.
- All children are welcome to take part in this event, regardless of whether they collect any sponsorship. Children must return their sponsorship forms in order to take part in this event. It is not compulsory to get any sponsors, but the form itself acts as a permission slip to take part, and therefore must be returned by Friday 8th March.

By 29 th March	Return sponsor form and sponsor money in an envelope via
	the red PTA box in the school entrance hall.

Your Class Reps will be asking for volunteers to assist with this event – please let them know if you are able to help. Please note that it is not possible to guarantee that you will be helping with your own child's class.
