### BEARS

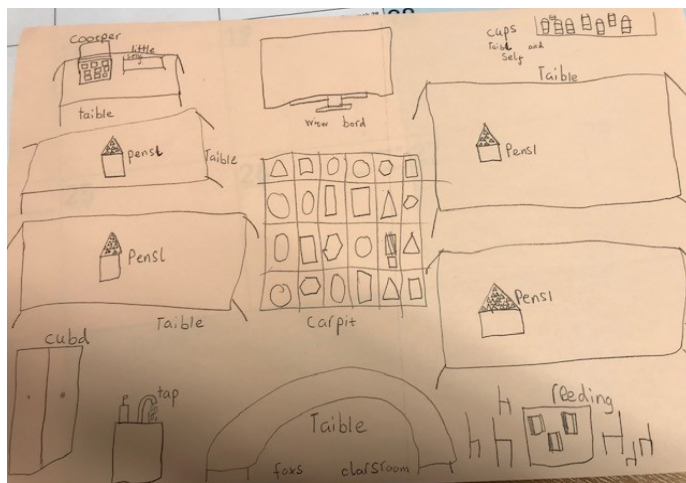
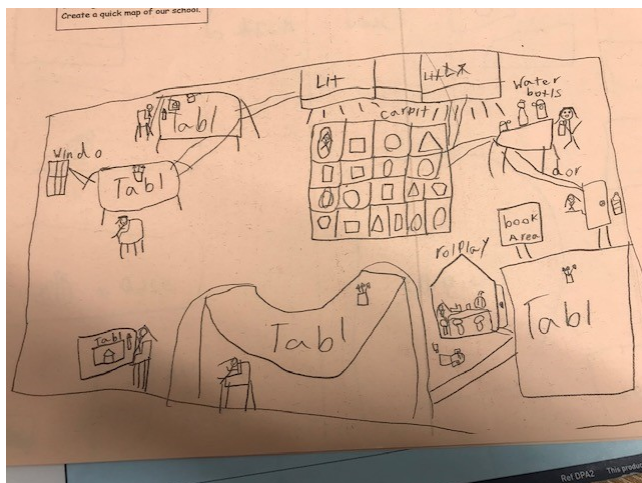
