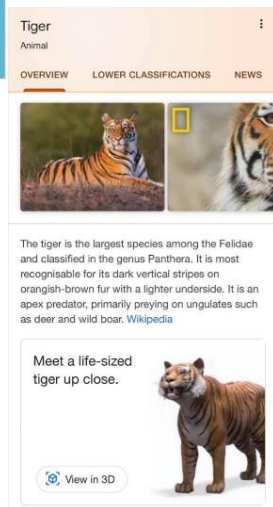

| Using objects can you add 2 (1 digit) numbers together and write down the number sentence using words such as add, plus, is and equals. | Write some clues for a treasure hunt around your house. | Create a picture out of loose parts that you find around your house e.g. bottle tops, corks, sticks, leaves, books, cutlery. | Go on a walk and look for signs of Spring. (You can also look for rainbows and bears in people's windows) | Choose a Cosmic Kids video on Youtube and complete it. |
| Play a board game, carefully moving your counter by the number the dice has shown. | Make your own tricky words pairs game. Listen to the tricky words song on Youtube. | Create a collage picture out of newspapers, magazines, tissue paper. | Go on a bug hunt outside – where do minibeasts like to live? | Choose a kids exercise video on Youtube and have a go. |
| Make a birthday crown and stick on the correct number of objects to match your age. | Write a postcard to a friend or someone in your family. | Create a puppet using some paper/card and a lollipop stick/twig. | Talk to someone in your family about what was different in the world when they were a child. | Have a race with a member of your family – who can balance a book on their head and walk down the stairs? |
| Using food can you make up a subtraction number sentence. | Read a rhyming book – can you finish off the lines that rhyme? | Make a stick man using twigs. | Create a flag for a country of your choice. | How long can you balance on one leg? Time everyone in your family! |
| Play a card game. | Write a story starting with 'Once upon a time...' | Build a den somewhere in your house or garden. | Have a look at a map. Find where we live and locate other countries that interest you. | Have a go at learning how to lace up a shoe – take the laces out of a trainer and lace it back up. |
