Pointillism is a special kind of artwork using dots!


You are going to create a painting using pointillist techniques

Pointillism

Pointillist artists create pictures made from tiny dots of colour. Pointillism can be used to create portraits or landscapes

George Seurat – France, 1859-1891

Seurat did not mix colours in a palette; he used dots of many different colours that are blended by the eyes of the viewer.





Bradley Hart – New York (Present Day)

Hart is taking pointillism in a new direction; he injects bubble wrap with paint to create images rather than painting onto canvas.



Bathers at Asnieres



Creating a Pointillist Picture

- Dipping a cotton bud in paint to create a picture (you may sketch your picture outline in pencil first)
- Painting onto bubble wrap and printing onto plain paper
- Or you could just print with paint on your finger!
