What does coming to school in a bubble mean?



Don't worry, coming to school in a bubble doesn't mean we will put you in an actual bubble.



A bubble is just a small group of people. Who will spend time together at school.  
You can think of it as a team.



It will include some of your friends and a grown up you already know from school.  
You might not have all your friends in your bubble, but you will have some of them.

Your 'bubble' will have a special name.

You will sing, relax, think, play and learn together.



Your bubble will have time inside and outside. It will be all yours. None of the other children will come into your bubble, and you won't go into their bubble space.



Even though we won't be spending time with the children in other bubbles, if we see them we can wave and shout 'hello'!

You will need to wear uniform, a red jumper/ white t shirt. if you have grown out of your uniform don't worry.



You will need to wear clean clothes every day.

When you arrive at school we will say goodbye to our grown up at the gate. Then we will lock the gate to make sure we are all safe. We will then go into school together.



We will go into our bubble classroom and put our coats on our chairs and go and wash our hands for 20 seconds.





The grown-ups know that you are in their bubble and are looking forward to working with you. Your bubble will be based in one of the classrooms and it will be your bubble's room.



The classrooms will look a bit different – the tables will be spaced out, there won't be lots of cushions or soft toys around. There will still be books and some toys.

You will have your own tray that includes a pencil, pen, whiteboard and rubber other equipment and things like that – you won't have to share!



The day will start by doing the register. Your friends and grown up will try to help you if you are feeling sad or worried about anything.

Your grown up will tell you about the plan for the day.

Everybody will be having a packed lunch in their bubble classroom.



You will still get to go outside for lots of exercise. Every bubble will have its own equipment. Your bubble will have its own play time. This may be at different times than you are used to.

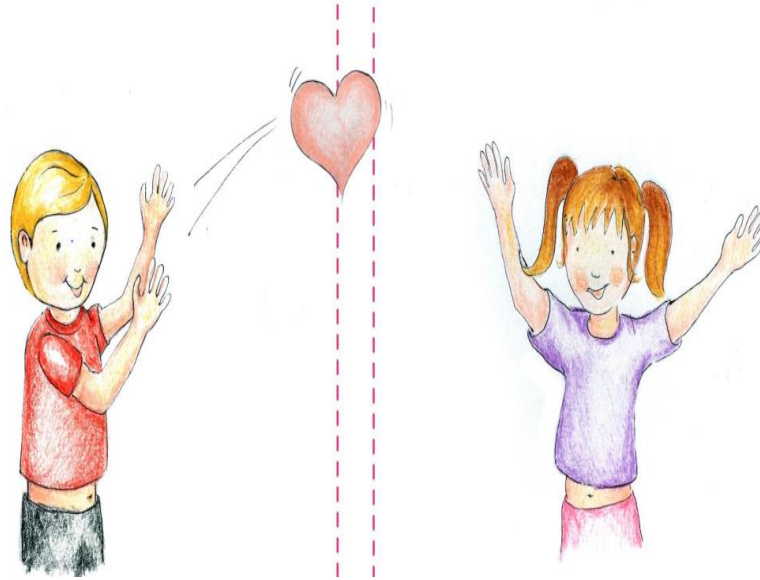
