


#### **Easy fundraising**

## Results from Last Year's Yr 2 class

We are pleased to share with families the results from last year's Y2 SATs and teacher assessments (2018/2019), which have now been analysed. The results show that we have continued our improving trend for good levels of attainment. When measured against all schools nationally, and against the local authority, children at Moss Lane have achieved very well, surpassing the national and local authority averages. In the Y1 phonics screening Moss Lane children achieved 92% this is higher than the local authority at 84% and national at 82%.

% of pupils achieving greater depth in Maths	39%	24%	22%

- Key stage 1 attainment of the expected standard in reading (88%) was significantly above national and in the highest 20% of all schools in 2019.
- Key stage 1 attainment of greater depth in writing (29%) was significantly above national and **in the highest 20% of all schools** in 2019.
- Key stage 1 attainment of greater depth in mathematics (39%) was significantly above national and **in the highest 20%** of all schools in 2019.

We are delighted with these results, we will continue to work hard to help all the children to make good progress in their learning so that we can continue to maintain this success.


## **Learning at Moss Lane...**

## **Bears**
