

Phonics Home Learning 06.07.20

Here are some sounds, words and sentences to practise writing and saying at home. We recommend doing 15 minutes of phonics each day.
The bird names are the different phonics groups and your child should know which one they are in.

	Can they recognise the sound when shown it? Can they read a selection of words with the sound in? Can they think of a different word with this sound in?	Can they recognise these tricky words? Can they say and write a sentence with these tricky words in?	Can they write these sentences after they have been dictated to them and write the correct sound each time? Have they spelt the words and tricky words correctly?
Magpies and Blackbirds	Phase 4: Decodable CCVC words using single letter sounds and digraphs. Can they have a go at writing some of these words?
