# Moss Lane School

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#### **Dear Families**

Can you believe it's the summer term and nearly the end of the school year! Where has that time gone? The summer term is always a busy one, full of exciting activities and of course, changes. Even at this early stage of the summer term, the children begin to think of what lies ahead. They will be full of mixed emotions; sadness as they near the end of their time in their current class and excitement and apprehension as they eagerly wait to move onto their new class or school. We will support them through this, encouraging positivity as I know you will too.

I'm sure like many, you were disappointed to hear that the roadmap of unlocking has been delayed until 19th July. As a school we will be remaining at stage 3 of our lockdown road map.

With schools now working on supporting children and families with transitions days can I please strongly encourage twice-weekly testing using rapid Lateral Flow Tests (LFT) of adults in all households with primary, secondary school and college aged children and young people, including childcare and support bubbles.

Currently Covid cases are rising at an increased rate locally. Surrey are closely monitoring the impact which is currently affecting secondary and primary-aged children and Surrey schools are seeing rising cases and bubble closures. We would really love to get to the end of term without having to close any bubbles, so we will do our best in school to adhere to our extensive risk assessment and ask for your support too.

If your child or any member of your household is displaying symptoms you must all isolate and book a PCR test for the symptomatic member.

Currently, children under 11 should NOT use lateral flow tests but must book a PCR test. You are then required to keep your child at home until you have had the results. I appreciate guidance is sometimes difficult to understand and navigate and changes frequently, so if you are not sure about anything, act with caution and give us a ring. We can then advise you.
