
READING



If you are not currently reading a little everyday with your child, please can you make it a priority. All the research shows that if children read a little every day at home, it has a massive impact on their progress. It only needs to be 10 minutes a day and it is one of the best gifts you can give to your child. Please fill in the reading diary to help the staff know how things are going, if you are in a rush a page number or a smiley face is fine. Remember to ask your

child a few questions about the story to make sure they are understanding what they have read.

COATS AND APPROPRIATE PE KIT



All children should have access to a warm winter coat during school time and this should be worn during break and lunchtimes. There are a number of children who have not had their coats in school. The children do have their playtimes outside even during light rain and those children without coats may be asked to remain under the cow shed on the playground. As part of our commitment to enhancing sporting provision, we will endeavour to ensure that PE takes place unless the playground conditions are considered to be dangerous or there is a torrential downpour. Again, please ensure that your child is equipped with a full PE kit,

stored in a drawstring bag and clearly labelled. This should include: Plain black shorts, red plain T-shirt/polo shirt (a change from their school clothing); jogging bottoms; a fleece or hooded top; plimsolls/trainers. Jewellery should not be worn in school for health and safety reasons. Thank you.

GET TEACHING
